### **Test Changes**

#### Lupus Anticoagulant Panel

The LA-Buffer, LA-Hex, Staclot-LA and Staclot-LA Interpretation have been removed from the panel. The Lupus Anticoagulant Panel now includes only the DRVVT Screen, with the DRVVT Confirm and mixing studies performed when indicated.

The Lupus Anticoagulant Staclot is now orderable as a stand-alone test.

## New Testing Pipeline

#### TEG (Thrombelastograph)

Laboratory Services is currently working on a TEG project with Emergency Medical Services. The TEG System is designed to perform whole blood coagulation testing by expressing a global functional hemostasis profile consisting of three dynamic systems: enzymatic, platelets and lytic systems. Testing will be performed in the laboratory and the real-time TEG hemostasis tracing can be viewed in the ED. The TEG analyzer records the viscoelastic changes in the whole blood sample as the sample clots, retracts and/or lyses.

This testing is available for use in trauma cases and other cases of excessive bleeding.
